



Uniform and General Appearance

Purpose:

This policy is to outline the dress code for all students when in school and when representing the school in the wider community. It is to inform parents, students and staff of the requirements as to what is worn, how to interpret the dress code and as a guideline to the implementation of the rules and consequences of the dress code.

General Policy Statement

As a community Uniform and General appearance identify and link us to our common goals. Respect for self and community is most obvious through appearance and uniform.

It is the responsibility of parents and students to purchase and maintain the correct school and sports uniform applicable to students' class level in the school. Students should travel to and from school in full school uniform. On a daily basis students should present themselves at school initially in school uniform only. The only exception to this is when other school activities are arranged prior to the day and publicly notified by the Principal.

It is the responsibility of all staff to monitor and implement the rules and regulations outlined below to ensure the correct application to the dress code. Teachers should be especially vigilant in assembly and teacher times each morning monitoring and reporting transgressions as required below.

We Do Not Expect:

- Tight fitted or skinny pants Jeggings/Leggings
- Incorrect uniform.
- Jewellery (except small stud ear-rings and wristwatch).
- Make-up, nail polish, dyed hair and long hair for boys.
- Girls long hair must be tied.
- You **MUST NOT** wear sandals or slip-on shoes. All school shoes must be closed shoes or trainers (Crocs, Uggs, Boots, etc are not allowed).
- You **MUST NOT** wear denim, jean-style trousers or track pants as part of your every day uniform.
- Your uniform must be clean and in good repair.



If in extreme circumstances you have to attend school out of uniform, you must always bring a note explaining why, show this to your teacher and any other teacher. We expect you to be in the correct uniform the following day.

NB: Students not meeting this dress code will be subject to the same sanctions as students in lower grade/year groups. This includes detentions, calls to parents and being sent home for consistent violations of the dress code.

The Senior Class Students will wear Special Color Polo Shirts and PE T-Shirts with their name printed on them.
